Global Teachers Award Online Course - Frequently Asked Questions

What is our Covid-19 response?

We are committed to supporting your learning and development at a time when all of us have to find new ways of working. Up to the end of summer Consortium of Development Education Centres (CoDEC) trainers will be delivering all our GTA courses online and continuing our relationship with British Council and DFID UK as a provider of one of the most successful courses within Connecting Classrooms through Global Learning

What has changed?

We've redesigned our face-to-face course to ensure your learning needs are met, your perspectives challenged and your professional practice inspired!

Our online courses are live sessions, on easy to use online platforms. The training programme includes collaborative learning as well as individual and small group offline activities, with virtual coaching and mentoring by our experienced specialist trainers.

We will be working hard to make sure you get a similar level of interaction, collaborative learning and specialist facilitator support as you would in our face to face training.

What is the cost?

The course is funded and approved for delivery within the CPD offer of Connecting Classrooms through Global Learning for eligible participants teaching in England. All we ask is that you attend each session and complete the tasks set before and after webinars to qualify for your funded place.

Who is eligible?

We have secured continued free access to the Global Teachers Award training for those working in state-funded schools, nursery settings, Pupil Referral Units and Sixth form/ Further Education colleges in England.

What is the time commitment?

The course is designed to take up to a maximum of 6 hours to include webinar participation, offline collaboration, study and reflection.



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Will I get a Global Teachers Award Certificate?

Global Teachers Award accreditation requires the submission of a reflective assignment based upon the planning and delivery of a global learning lesson to your class.

The online course offers an alternative pathway with activities designed to support you to complete a Global Teachers Award application when the time is right for you.

Everyone who successfully completes the online course will receive an online course completion certificate. Your trainer will provide further information on how to apply for a Global Teachers Award certificate.

Can I book this training for my school or cluster?

This training is designed for participation by individuals from different schools, rather than whole school groups. Training courses are capped at 10 participants to maintain quality, rigour and a personal approach.

When will face to face training return?

British Council has suspended all face to face training under CCGL programme at the current time. We will return to face to face training when it is safe to do so.
